NOW upon hearing the said Complaint upon Oath, touching the premisses above: We the said Justices do hereby adjudge the said Complaint to be True, and do hereby also adjudge and declare the said Ann Marlaid Thomas Joseph Mary and Hannah her children

to be Poor, and actually Tyldesley with Shakerley chargeable to Tyldesley with Shakerley afore said; and that their last legal Settlement is in the Township of Ashton under Lincolne in the said County. These are therefore in his Majesty's Name to require you the Church-Wardens and Overseers of the Poor of the Township of Tyldesley with Shakerley afore said, to remove and convey the said Ann Marlaid Thomas Joseph Mary and Hannah her children

from Tyldesley with Shakerley afore said, to Ashton under Lincolne afore said and there - deliver to the Church-Wardens, and Overseers of the Poor thereof, together with a true Copy of this our Order, which said Church-Wardens and Overseers of the Poor of Ashton under Lincolne afore said, are likewise hereby required to receive and provide for them according to Law. Herein fail not at your Peril. Given under our Hands and Seals this Twenty Fourth Day of March in the Year of our Lord one Thousand seven hundred and fifty seven.
