next unto to come, and the governour and tyme of death most uncertayne, And so words trouble wth myght enbrow
herafter, pryncipally by the assistance of gode Holye spirit to sett forth my will in order, as god in his mercy hath bestowed upon
me, doe institute ordayne and make this my last will and testament containing herein my last will in maner and forme followinge
That is to saye first above all thinge I comend my soule into the hande of almightie god my true trust beinge to be saved
only by the faith of his deathe meritt and bloodsheddinge of Iesus Christ myne onlye saviour and reddeemour, and
my bodye to comitt to the earth from whence yt came, to be buried in the church of Ashton under Lyne as now to
my husbande always be trustinge to have a glorious Resurrection, and for my worldly good I direct them as
followeth: Item it is my last will and mynde, that at my dette shalbe payde of my whole good, And then yt is my last
will and mynde, and I give and bequeath unto Sara my daughter a ffewerbed, a bolster, a pillowe, two new
blankette, a new coverlett, a paper of ffine fflapen stiffe: Item I give unto Walter my sonne, a coverlet, two
blankette, a bolster, a pillowe, a paper of ffine, and a chaffe bedde, all best intent to keepe for my selfe in and by
this my last will bequeathed unto Sara my daughter; Item I give unto my sonne John Marland, all plowes
harrowes, cartes, wth all thinge belonginge to husbandrye. two greates oxen, and two calves, and bedclothes to be given
a bedde. Item I give to every one to whom I am god mother aijd a p^{er}son: Item after my death bringinge to paye
bequeathed & formed and ffmerall expence discharged, all the rest of my good I give to be equally divided
betwixt my two children Walter and Sara to be equally divided betwixt them, Item it is my last will and
mynde that my good children John Walter and Sara wth all to them in and by this my last will bequeathed
shalbe under the tuition and government of George Silvester my brother untill they shalbe come to the age
of one and twentieth yeeres: And yt is my last will and mynde that their portions of good shalbe employed
and bestowed for their best profitt and advantage untill they shalbe come to the age aforesayde: Item I
constitute ordayne and make the true and lawfull ex^{ecutors} of this my last will the sayde George
Silvester my brother, and John Marland my sonne, And overseers of the same Anselmus Fozz and
James Marland.

Item I give unto my good children John Walter and Sara their whole portions given and bequeathed unto
them by my late husband John Marland their father this last will, as by this will, and inventory of his good
appeareth:
