

In the name of God Amen, the Thirteenth day of February Anno Domini 1632 And in the eight  
years of the reign of our souverain Lord Charles by the grace of God King of England & Scotland  
& Ireland & of the British Isles Marquess of Hertford with the gift of Aston  
Underlyng in the County of Lancaster a man demore in good health and full remembrance prayeth  
to God yet findinge the veray nature and consideringe the mortallitie of all mankind doth ordaine  
constitute and make this present Testamēt containinge herin my last Will in this manner and forme  
as followeth: First and principally I give bequath and beate my soule into the handes of almighty  
God my creater and maker travinge only by the merites of Christ his death and passion to bee one  
of his elect and his children: And my body I bequeath to the earth from whence it came to bee  
buried in due and decent order all and by the direction of my friends: And for the order and distri-  
bution of such goods, chattells, malletts and debts as god hath blessed me withall and as are due unto  
me, my mynd and will is ad honora deo folloeweth Imprimis out of my whole goods I give thereto  
legataries followinge, first I give and bequeath unto John Leeth, Jonathan Leeth, Robert Leeth, and  
Ann Leeth children of John Leeth the younger of Littlemoss my sonne in law to everie one of them  
xxiiii pounds a yeare Item I give unto Anna and Sarah Maryland children of Myles Maryland  
my sonnes to bee equally deuided betwixt them, and delived unto them when they shall accomplish the age of  
one and twenty yeare or else bee married by the consent of my sonnes in law John Leeth aforesaid and  
if either of them shall dy before such tyme as aforesaid then of it my will and mynd that the p[ar]t he  
shall haue all Item I give and bequeath unto William Leeth my servant xxiiii pounds or else a sume  
worth so much to bee at his owne election and purpos whether to haue Item yet is my will and  
mynd that all the rest and residue of my said goods, chattells, malletts and debts shall bee diuided into  
three equall parts whereof I will that Joan my wiffe shall haue one equall part to her owne purpos  
the names of her purpos and reasonable parte to her of all my said goods, chattells, malletts and debts and  
the second equall parte of all my said goods, chattells, malletts and debts I give and bequeath unto my  
daughter Ann now wiffe of John Leeth of Littlemoss aforesaid, And the third equall parte of all my said  
goods, chattells and debts after my funerall expences and charges about the probate of this my last  
will and Testamēt bee performed and deducted out of the same I give and bequeath unto the said Ann  
my daughter now wiffe of the said John Leeth, And of this my present Testamēt I make and ordaine  
the said John Leeth my sonne in law my true and lawfull Executor And I desyre Robert Leeth of the  
Lum, and Charles apell of Aston Underlyng to bee Churcheys of the same to see it truly executed  
and I further recke and admitt all and everie other former Testamēt with legataries bequests, executors  
and churcheys by me in any wylle before this tyme heretofore named willed and bequeathed
