charitie as to poor needy people mardens marriage and mending of hugh waies sin^{ns} to witte Item of

of anoble a yarde Item I bequeth to maister Thomas freant gentilmann a blak gowne and to my wife
hys wife a nother of a noble the yarde making him out of this my testament giving him a
king of golde of the value of xxx s. praying him to a siffe my wife wth his frendly feith full counsel
Item I bequeth to my suster harolme a blak gowne of like price and a king of golde of the value
of xx nobles making her a nother out of this my will praying her to pray for me of her goodnes
Item I bequeth my brother hugh Crispe a blak gowne and my suster hys wife a nother and to my
brother Richard Crispe a nother Item I bequeth to Anne my suster now dwelling in the Citie a blak
gowne and xxx s. in money Item I will every oon of my suster blak gowne of the value of my will
Item where as I have given noo reward to my brother Thomas Crispe neither I trust he will call
to his remembrance money due unto me and my wife hys suster in conscience and by good right neither
he will shew himself a swoll therefor as for naturall brotherly melignation to the comforte of hys suster
for the forbearing thereof hath discomantaged me and profited him Item I will that my body brought
to earth my funeralls to be paid and layd out of my goodes to my wife praying
my will and testament Item I will that my Coffin nicolab shroove Clerk a gowne and a pane of
cynthia beads garnishid with silke garnishid Item I will to Edward maland whan he cometh to hys
age of xxij yeres to pray for my soule This will to stande good and effectuell wth out I doo
chaunge my mynde hereafter as it shall please god ameyn J per me willm yerland merer J
